FROM RARE DISEASES TO FUNCTIONAL ENDOCRINE CONDITIONS: DECIPHERING WHEN TO TREAT AND WHEN TO SCREEN

Hypogonadotropic hypogonadism is a condition of low sex hormones due to decreased gonadal stimulation by the hypothalamic-pituitary system. It can be due to both congenital genetic disorders (CHH) and acquired conditions, such as adenomas and other locally destructive diseases or secondary functional forms. Yet recent evidence has shown that these conditions are not always easy to separate, and some adult-onset forms may harbor a genetic predisposition. Therefore, the treatment decision can be difficult, but understanding the mechanisms and clinical outcomes of the so-called functional acquired forms could facilitate this task.
